Steps to take before building

- Contact the POA Building and Architectural Committee and inform them of your intent to build on your lot by sending an email to; <u>queensgap.president@gmail.com</u>. You will be put in touch with someone on the Building and Architectural Committee.
- 2. Complete Pre-Construction Checklist found on our website.
- 3. Send this checklist along with;
 - 1. a copy of your house plans that show square footage and roof elevations.
 - a copy of your Site Plan showing the approximate location of your house in relation to lot boundaries and roads. The site plan is necessary to determine if there would be a conflict with right-of-ways, setbacks, and/or easements.
 - 3. exterior color selections
 - 4. contractor proof of insurance (Declaration Page will do).
- 4. Someone from the committee will get back to you within 2 weeks with an approval of your package or discuss why your package was not approved and how to remedy. This approval will be required before construction can begin.
- 5. Talk with your builder about the concrete truck restrictions the POA imposes on new construction. The restriction of not more than 5 yards of concrete per truck will increase your overall costs. Decide how this increase will be covered before work starts. Fine for each overloaded truck is \$200.
